EECTs will be offered as feasible and by request

ALL entries must be accompanied by the correct fees (US funds only), the completed entry form, and documentation of prior trailing titles earned for each dog entered as indicated below:

Mantrailer: One copy of the EECT multi-part form issued by the passing judge.

Mantrailer Intermediate: One copy of the MT certificate

Mantrailer Excellent: One copy of the MTI certificate

All entries must include the judge's names that passed the dog at the previous level(s)

Lottery Selection Procedure:

If more entries per event are received for any trailing level than there are trails available, participants will be selected by lottery (see Sections 9.1 and 9.2 of the ABC Trailing Trial Standard). Alternates for trails will be drawn in compliance with the Trailing Trial Standard; after completing the lottery selection procedure, the event secretary will email (or US Postal Mail) all entrants of their standing. All entries over and above confirmed and alternate status will be returned to those persons submitting the entries.

Entry Fees (US funds only):

Mantrailer \$55/Mantrailer Intermediate \$75/Mantrailer Excellent \$100. EECTs (\$25) may be requested and will be accommodated if possible.

Entries for the trailing trial close on Tuesday, June 30, 2009, at 5:00 PM, and must be received by the trailing trial secretary by that date and time. Entries must be sent via US mail; faxed and/or emailed entries will NOT be accepted.
