Trailing Levels / Number of Trails Offered:

2 Mantrailer / 2 Mantrailer Intermediate / 1 Mantrailer Excellent

ALL entries must be accompanied by the correct fees (US funds only), the completed entry form, and documentation of prior trailing titles earned for each dog entered as indicated below:

Mantrailer: One copy of the EECT certificate

Mantrailer Intermediate: One copy of the MT certificate

Mantrailer Excellent: One copy of the MTI certificate

Lottery Selection Procedure:

If more entries per event are received for any trailing level than there are trails available, participants will be selected by lottery (see Sections 9.1 and 9.2 of the ABC Trailing Trial Standard). Alternates for trails will be drawn in compliance with the Trailing Trial Standard; after completing the lottery selection procedure, the event secretary will email all entrants of their standing. All entries over and above confirmed and alternate status will be returned to those persons submitting the entries.

EECTs (\$25) may be requested and will be accommodated if possible.

Clyde Reed was a life member of the American Bloodhound Club, an honorary deputy sheriff in Pierce County, Washington, and a founding member of the Northwest Bloodhound Search and Rescue organization. His dedication to bloodhounds, participation in mantrailing, and support of beginning and veteran dog-and- handler teams will long be remembered.

Clyde was preceded in death by his son David and his wife Lena, who co-authored *The Complete Bloodhound*, *The New Complete Bloodhound*, and *Manhunters! Hounds of the Big T*. Together, Clyde and Lena were an excellent mantrailing team with Clyde's handling of the bloodhounds and Lena's keeping meticulous records and being ever willing to go out and get lost.

Many will remember Clyde and Lena's bloodhounds, who were equally at home in the show ring or on the trail: Boomerang, Melody, Chocolate Candy, Fearless Fosdick, Maccabee, and Henrietta.

Clyde leaves an extended family: second wife Ruth, his daughter, Bobbi Eller, his son Richard (Rico) Reed, their spouses, and several grandchildren and great grandchildren, not to mention numerous friends, bloodhounds, and search and rescue teams who mourn his passing.
